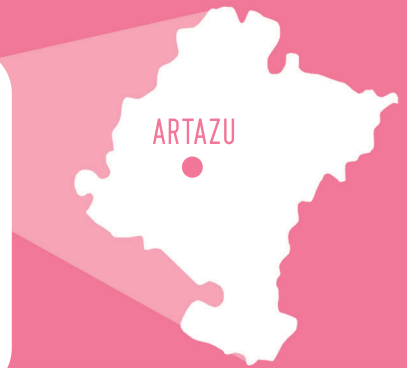


WINERY HISTORY

Ah-So is produced at the Lopez de LaCalle Artazu property in Navarra Spain. The winery was established in 1996 after Juan Carlos Lopez de LaCalle inspired by his friendship with pioneering Central Coast vintner Randall Graham of Bonny Doon found old deprived vineyards in the town of Artazu. Artazu is located in the Valdizarbe sub zone of Navarra it is the most northerly and cool region flanked by the Pyrenees Mountain range and the Atlantic ocean. Juan Carlos was captivated by the vineyards and landscape. They decided to purchase the few remaining ancient vineyards blocks around Artazu and plant new vineyards with the cuttings from the old vines. The new vineyards were planted to ensure that the Lopez de LaCalle family had the raw material to produce the most outstanding rosé wines from Artazu. Traditionally, Rosé wines were the most famous and acclaimed wines produced in the region.

VINYARDS

Placed in Artazu, between 450 and 500 meters of Altitude, laid on clay-limestone soils.



VITICULTURE

Maximum respect to the environment, lack of pests or herbicides. Organic viticulture.

HARVEST

Hand harvest, picking in 200kg boxes. Sorting of bunches. Average yield of 5,000 kg/hectare

GRAPE VARIETY

100% Garnacha

STATS

Alc 12.50% | pH 3.15 | T. Acidity: 6.52 g/l

VINIFICATION

Free run, stainless steel vats, termination during 18-20 days.
